## Addendum 1

### CAA Facility Report

May 1, thru June 19, 2024

1. Ordered 2 new toilet paper dispensers. Replaced damaged one in women's bathroom. A spare is now in the storage room.
2. Cleaned up debris, stones blacktop, concrete, moss, etc. placed on picnic table and sidewalk from kid's school outing. Prepped and resealed table due to numerous scratches. Also, debris was placed in sand lot.
3. Repaired walk-in cooler compressor.
4. Returned all empty bun crates to Piggly Wiggly
5. Groomed infields several times.
6. Groomed Ron Rohlinger field
7. Cleaned and groomed plants in CP sign
8. Leveled bases in the infields.
9. Groomed south lot 3 times after burn outs in gravel from vehicles and 4 wheelers.
10. Tightened drive belt in gator.
11. Repaired flush valve in women's toilet.
12. Repaired fence in various areas.
13. Sprayed various areas for weed growth at CP.
14. Sprayed for bees / wasps throughout complex.
15. Reset chains wound around the top rail in playground swing set.
16. Graded all infields with grader provided by Baumhardt Sand and Gravel. Grader was used 12.5 hours. Mobilization is all that will be charged for usage.
17. Graded and reshaped damage to lower parking lot. Used Baumhardt grader for 3 hours and groomer for 1 hour. Hand labor was 1 hour as well. The police chief was notified, and repair costs were provided to her.
18. Used Baumhardt grader to shape drainage area south of storage shed.
19. Shaped and placed new mulch around planter CP sign.
20. Several hours prepping infields due to extensive rainfall in an effort not to call off games. Removed old much from planter and installed new
21. Used grader to removed lip on service road area to storage shed to allow proper storm water flow.
22. Routinely checked cooler compressor.
23. Repaired fence on basketball court.
24. Replaced burnt out light on pavilion.
25. Tightened and replaced keeper to light on CP sign planter.
26. Repaired bolt in playground slid.
27. Replaced teeth on Vibraflex attachment with help of Tim Gellings
28. Cleaned debris from trees after rain and wind events.
29. Cut off and disposed of broken branches from trees.
30. Pitcher mound trailer was repaired.... welded broken axles, straightened mounting frames, replacement of tires and tubes added Liquitube tire sealant for preventative maintenance. Repainted entire structure.

31. Cleaned and lubricated cooler compressor....we may have to consider a replacement next year. This unit is 32 years old.
32. Repaired kick panel in concession stand.
33. Repaired 2 picnic tables
34. Moved anchor pin on #1 field at 3rd base with help from Tim Gellings.
35. Applied topsoil, seed, fertilizer and mulch to shaped drainage area south of storage shed.
36. Attended to burnout in south parking lot called to me by persons attending softball game Tuesday night 6/18. Called non-emergency FDL county sheriff department. Officer arrived and attended to situation with individual who raked ruts back in place as I stayed with him.
